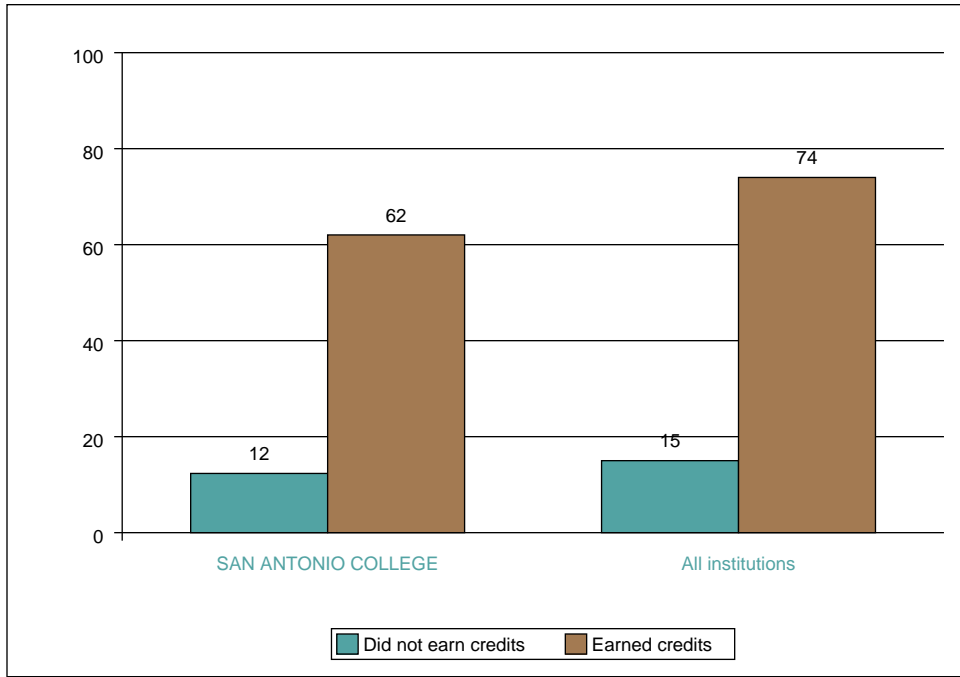
Figure 1.--Percentage of Achieving the Dream students earning zero credits during the first term, and percentage of zero-credit earners persisting to the second term, by selected characteristics
