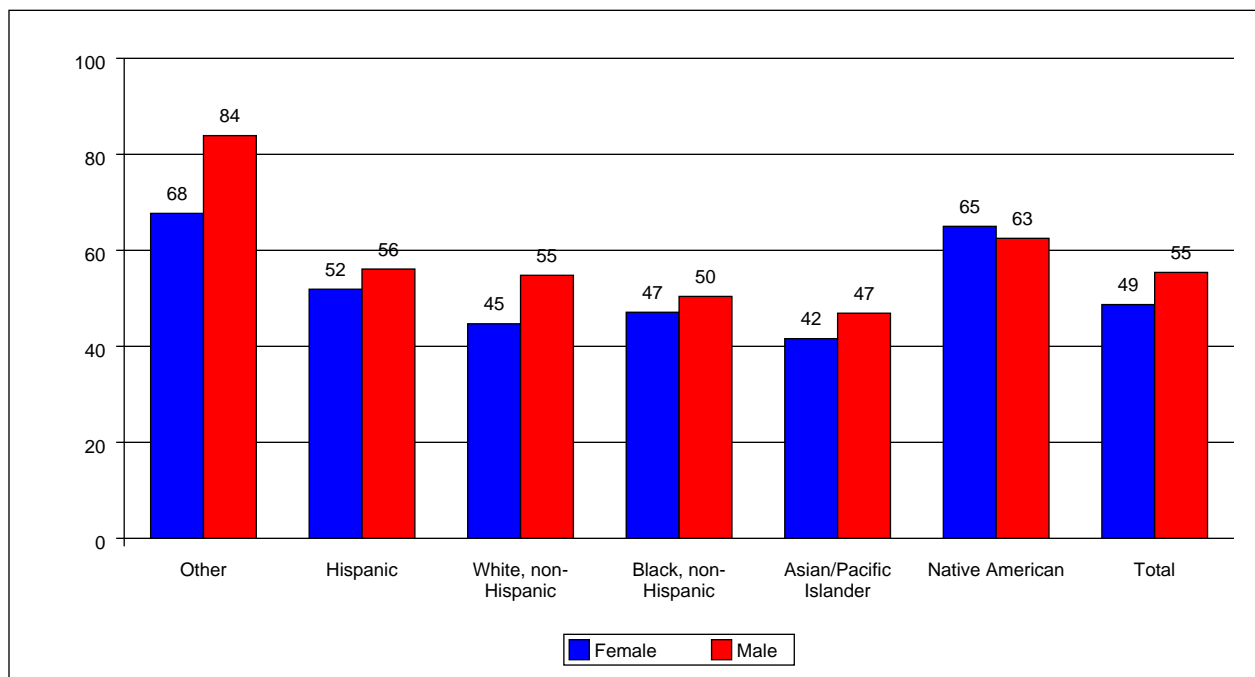


Figure 2.--Percentage of 2003 Achieving the Dream cohort referred to developmental education, by gender and race/ethnicity

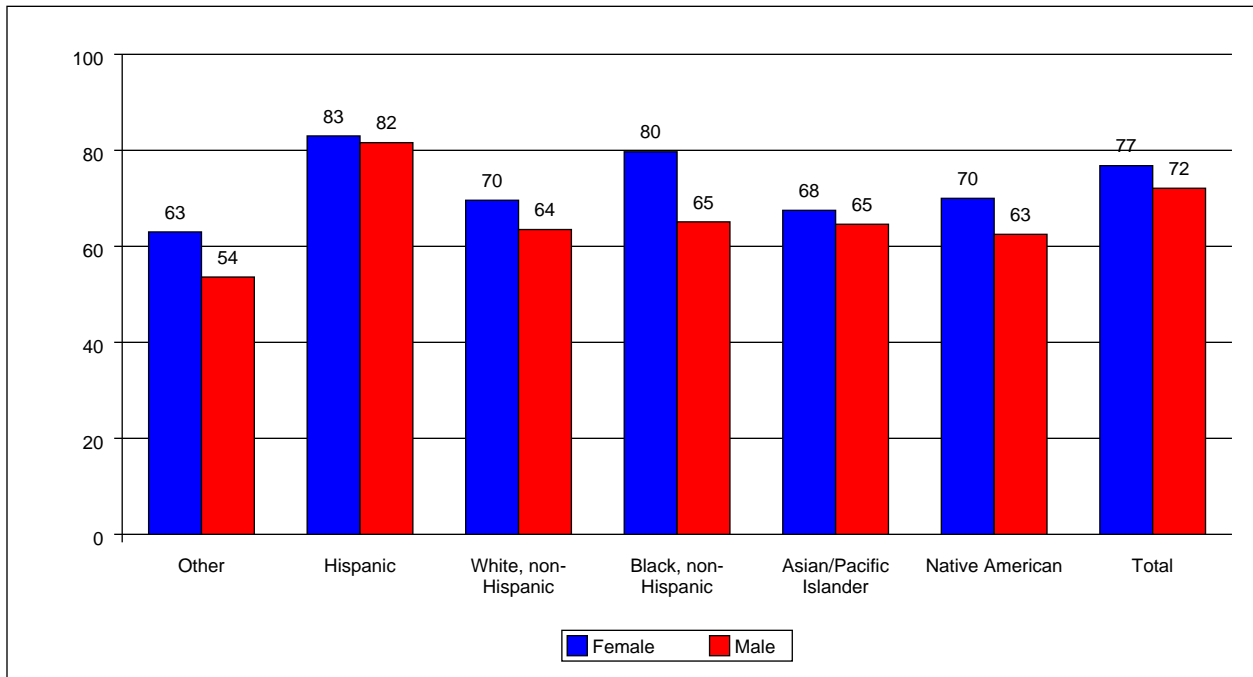


Figure 3.--Percentage of 2003 Achieving the Dream cohort persisting to the second term, second year and third year, by gender and race/ethnicity
