SUBJECT: **COMMENDATION DPS CASE # 06-2-19548**

During the evening hours on November 27, 2006 a female student at St. Philips College was walking to her vehicle to leave campus after attending classes. As she approached her vehicle she was attacked by two unknown individuals, brutally assaulted and robbed. The two suspects fled the scene and remained at large.

You were assigned to conduct the follow up investigation. In doing so you were able to establish the identity of two suspects and ultimately develop positive identification on one of them who was ultimately arrested and charged with Aggravated Robbery. This suspect subsequently entered a guilty plea to the charge and was assessed a twenty year prison sentence of which he has to serve a minimum of ten years prior to being eligible to apply for parole.

You are to be commended for your work on this case. As a result of your investigative skill and action the individual responsible for the brutal physical assault and robbery of a student was identified, charged and successfully convicted.
