On August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2007 while on patrol at San Antonio College in Lot #7 you came across a subject removing a spare tire from a sport utility vehicle. When the subject saw you he began walking away. You looped through the parking lot and upon circling back around to where you first observed the subject he was now placing a spare tire in the bed of a pick – up truck. The subject fled on foot when he saw you the second time leaving the pick – up truck and spare tire behind. You gave pursuit but were unable to catch the subject.

Upon further investigation you discovered four spare tires in the bed of the pick – up truck that had been abandoned by the suspect. You were subsequently able to determine that two of the four spare tires in the bed of the pick – up truck belonged to vehicles parked in Lot #7 which were registered to students. You had the students contacted and they were able to positively identify the tires as their property which was subsequently released to them. The abandoned vehicle and the two remaining spare tires were impounded and held as evidence pending further investigation.

You are to be commended for your observations, initiative and attention to duty. As a result, a theft in progress was stopped and property belonging to two students of the Alamo Community Colleges at San Antonio College had their property recovered and returned to them.
