- .10 Officers will take action only on warrants reported through the T.C.I.C. / N.C.I.C. system.
- .11 Person(s) arrested for warrants reported through T.C.I.C. / N.C.I.C. will be turned over to the Bexar County Warrant Officer on duty if no charges are to be filed by the Alamo Colleges Police Department.
- .12 When person(s) arrested on charges by the Alamo Colleges Police Department have other jurisdiction warrants, jail personnel at the Magistrate's Office will be told of the warrant. Under no circumstances will a booking slip be prepared for other jurisdiction warrants.
- .20 Traffic and municipal warrants of other jurisdictions will not be checked as a matter of routine however, they may be checked as an investigative tool to hold a person suspected of a crime or a suspect under investigation.
  - A. Checks for traffic and municipal warrants of other jurisdictions that are requested through the Communications Division shall be done only with the approval of a Patrol Supervisor.
  - B. Traffic and municipal warrants for other jurisdictions that are discovered through the MDT system shall not be acted upon without authorization of a Patrol Supervisor.
- .30 Officers will respond to other jurisdiction warrants not in T.C.I.C. / N.C.I.C. if assistance is solicited by that jurisdiction and they are prepared to take charge of the prisoner in a reasonable amount of time.
