C.2.5 (Policy) Auxiliary Enterprises

Auxiliary enterprises may be established, with the intent of being self-supporting activities, primarily to provide non-instructional services for the benefit of students, faculty, and staff. The general public may be incidentally served by the auxiliary enterprises. Fees are charged for the project or services provided. Auxiliary enterprises may include, but are not limited to, such activities as bookstores, food service, childcare centers, and similar operations.

All auxiliary enterprise activities shall be operated in a fiscally responsible manner.
