

Alamo Community College District Foundation, Inc. San Antonio Livestock Exposition (S.A.L.E.) Scholarship Application (Revised February 27, 2009)

The Alamo Community College District (ACCD) Foundation and the San Antonio Livestock Exposition are looking for excellent students who want challenging and rewarding careers which can have a major impact upon the quality of life in tomorrow's farming and ranching communities.

If you are going to be just starting your college education and pursuing courses as a full time student leading to a degree in any of the declared majors indicated in the attached listings, and you have strong academic potential and motivation as demonstrated by your high school GPA, then you should apply for an ACCD Foundation S.A.L.E. Scholarship.

These Scholarships are available to students who will enroll in one of the ACCD Colleges (currently Palo Alto College, San Antonio College, St. Philip's College, Northwest Vista College, or Northeast Lakeview College) as a full time student (minimum of 12 credit hours per semester) for two complete academic years, completing their freshman and sophomore years if pursuing a baccalaureate degree major prior to transferring to a senior institution, or completing an associates degree major as conferred by one of the ACCD Colleges. Twelve (12) credit hours must be completed each regular semester to qualify for funding in the subsequent semester (i.e. a S.A.L.E. Scholarship recipient is not to withdraw from courses that would result in not completing at least 12 credit hours per semester. One semester may be forgiven for extenuating circumstances).

Scholarship candidates must also be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States, and must have been a resident of Bexar, Atascosa, Bandera, Comal, Gillespie, Guadalupe, Kendall, Medina, Wilson, Frio, Karnes or Kerr counties in Texas for at least six (6) months prior to the application being submitted. Scholarship candidates must have earned a minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale to qualify. A grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 each semester in college, not cumulative, must be maintained to qualify for funding each subsequent semester (one semester may be forgiven for extenuating circumstances).

The Scholarship is for \$1,000 per semester for two consecutive academic years for tuition, fees, books and required materials for a total of \$4,000.

* I must be a senior in high school or a high school graduate from Bexar, Atascosa, Bandera, Comal, Gillespie, Guadalupe, Kendall, Medina, Wilson, Frio, Karnes or Kerr County in Texas to be considered for an ACCD Foundation S.A.L.E. Scholarship.

* I must declare my major as being one of those on the list of S.A.L.E. Scholarship Acceptable Majors as provided in the attachment to this application. I understand I must enroll in courses which directly support the pursuit of my declared major. For approved majors at the ACCD, these courses are clearly identified in the College Bulletins.

* I must **enroll in, and complete**, a minimum of 12 college-level credit hours each semester for 4 consecutive semesters at a college of the Alamo Community College District. I must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 **each** semester. If I do not achieve these minimum requirements during any semester I may request an exception (for one semester only) by submitting a letter of extenuating circumstances and a plan for improvement to the ACCD Foundation. **If I fail to comply with this requirement, my S.A.L.E. Scholarship will not be renewed.**

* I understand and agree that upon registration each semester, my official course schedule, and transcript of grades from previous semesters, will be provided to the ACCD Foundation and the San Antonio Livestock Exposition Scholarship Office as long as I may receive this scholarship. I may also accelerate my education by attending summer sessions as a full time student and may request, in writing, approval to apply my scholarship award for summer school.
