Open Admissions Policy to all Colleges

The Alamo Community Colleges have an open door admissions policy to ensure that every person has the opportunity to get a college education. Applications starts with the submission of an ApplyTexas* application. Students who apply to one college are eligible to attend any of the Alamo Community Colleges: Northeast Lake College, Northwest Vista College, Palo Alto College, St. Philip’s College and San Antonio College.

Tips for Success in completing the ApplyTexas Application:

1. Process should take between 15 and 30 minutes.
2. Checklist of items needed to complete Application:
3. Social Security Number
4. Email address
5. VISA/Permanent Resident Information
6. TASP/THEA or other TSI assessment scores
7. SAT, ACT, and/or TAAS/TAKS 11 scores and test dates
8. Name and dates of high school and college attended

Apply on-line using the ApplyTexas application [**www.ApplyTexas.org**](http://www.ApplyTexas.org)

1. Begin by creating your student profile
2. Select the Two-Year Undergraduate Application
3. Following submission of the application
4. Notate your User ID and password so you may access the ApplyTexas website in the future.
