APPLICATION:

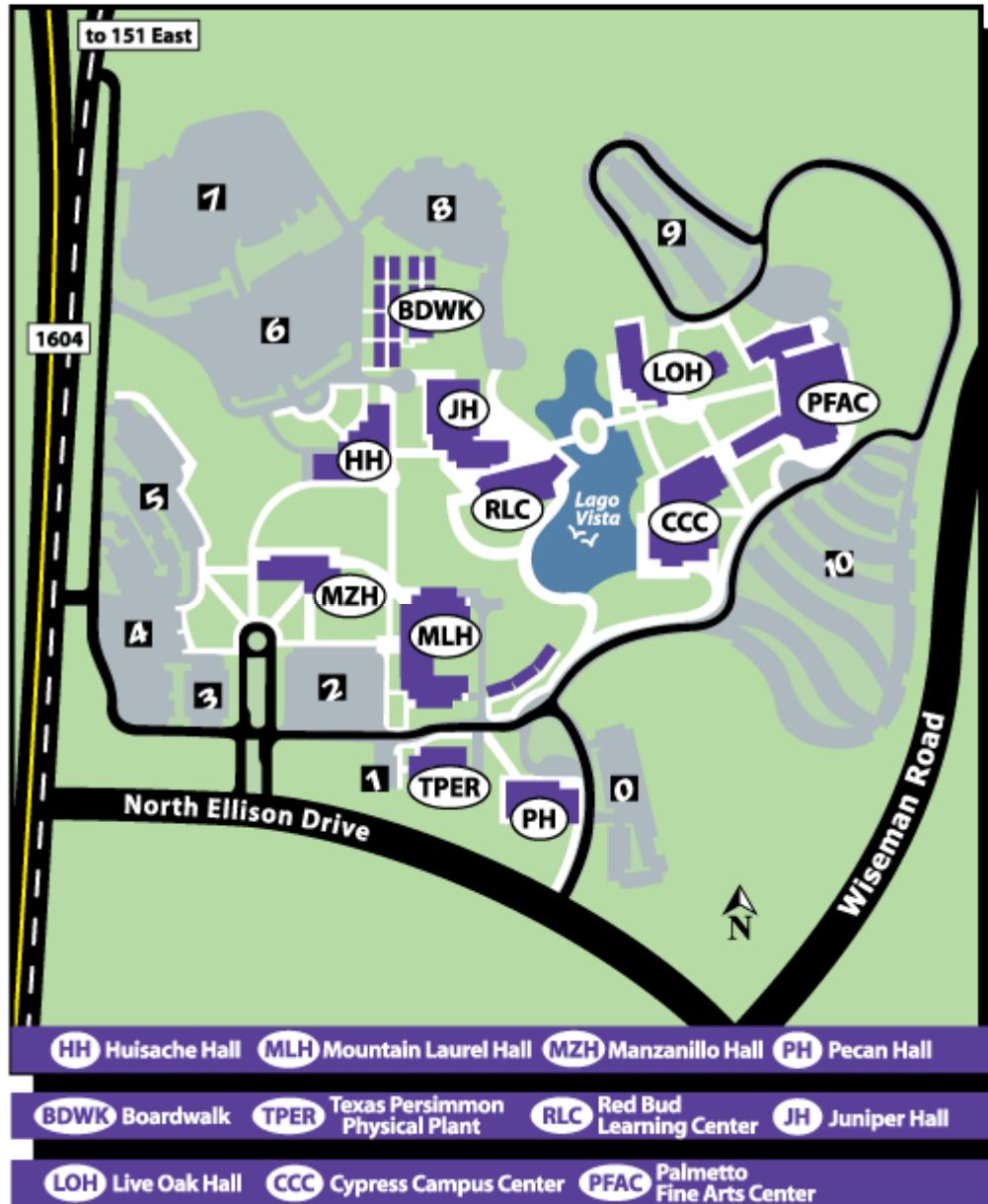
