## International Studies Scholarships

The ACCD Foundation has made funds available for scholarships to students who will be participating in approved faculty-led ACCD study abroad programs during 2007. In order to be eligible for consideration for scholarship funds, students are required to meet the following requirements:

- 1) Students must be enrolled in a degree program at any of the colleges of the ACCD. Continuing education students and students enrolled in certificate programs are not eligible.
- 2) Students enrolled in non-ACCD institutions are not eligible.
- 3) Students must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours during the program.
- 4) Students must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or greater.
- 5) A completed FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) must be on file at the Financial Aid Office. The FAFSA may be completed at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). *This step is required even if the student does not seek Federal Student Aid or is ineligible.*
- 6) Students must complete a Student Financial Services Scholarship Application (attached).
- 7) On a separate sheet, students must answer the Questions for International Studies Scholarships (attached).
- 8) Students must submit a letter of acceptance by the study abroad or international studies faculty advisor.
- 9) Students must seek alternate funding sources including, but not limited to, parental support, scholarships, grants and loans. Award letters and denial letters may be required.
- 10) Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Applications must be received by the Office of International Programs, Alamo Community College District, 201 W. Sheridan, San Antonio, TX 78204 no later than **Monday, March 2, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. CST**. Students may return completed applications to faculty members or international studies advisors, but the Office of International Programs must receive all materials by the above deadline.

Applications for scholarships will be reviewed by international studies committee and winners will be notified by email and/or U.S. mail.
