

The proposed enhanced Senior Summer Bridge Program, a partnership between San Antonio College (SAC) and San Antonio Independent School District (SAISD) will directly target at least 100 graduates from inner-city high schools whose population is 97% Hispanic. The proposed project will provide an enhanced Summer Bridge experience for a minimum of 100 SAISD students (predominantly FGIC), based on Accuplacer score results. Students will be provided with developmental coursework at SAC through SAC's existing Senior Summer Bridge Program. Courses offered will include one level of remedial English, three levels of Reading, and four levels of remedial Mathematics. Grant funding will enhance this coursework with one-on-one small group and individual tutoring in the Math laboratory and with writing assistance through SAC's Writing Center, both in-class and one-on-one, conducted by Math and English faculty. The Outcome Objectives for this project are that 1) by 7/30/07, Accuplacer post-Bridge scores will show that 95% of Senior Summer completers have increased their readiness for college-level coursework; and 2) by 8/30/07, at least 85% of Senior Summer completers will have enrolled in higher education in Fall 2008 with between one and seven hours of college credit.
