<p>The Support Field must be approved by the TAMUSA Department of HKN Chair. The Support Field requires 18 hours, chosen by the student and the advisor. Six of the 18 hours should be advanced courses (I.E., 3000-or 4000–level courses). Lower-level courses (i.e., 1000-level or 2000- level courses) from San Antonio College will be accepted, as long as the course prefix (e.g., ENGL, HIST) is within the support field. Advanced courses offered by TAMUK or TAMUSA will be accepted. Advanced courses from other institutions may be accepted in transfer. The TAMUSA Department of HKN Chair will make the decision for acceptance and should be consulted prior to enrolling in classes at another institution.</p>
