## • Call for Art History/Theory Papers - Corpus Christi 2004

We are broadening the scope of the presentations, so topics need no longer be limited to art history. Nor will there be a focus on a particular theme for the talks. We invite art historians, artists, art theoreticians, critics, and philosophers to submit proposals in any of their areas of interest that might appeal to **TASA** members. Non-members who teach art in Texas colleges and universities may qualify for submission of a proposal by simply joining **TASA**.

We encourage the use of slides and other visual aids. Extemporaneous presentations are generally better received than formal readings. Three papers will be presented successively within a 90-minute period. Each speaker will be allotted 20 minutes for presentation. Questions and answers will follow the last talk.

If you are interested in participating as a speaker, please send an abstract of your proposal (electronic if possible) or a completed paper to Carey Rote by March 15, 2004. At least one university art professor and the TASA president will review all proposals. Preference will be given to entries received before March. Notices of acceptance and rejection will be sent during March 2004. Non-members who teach art in Texas colleges and universities may qualify for submission of a proposal by simply joining TASA.
