State Testing and Assessment

(Contact the RAFB Alamo Colleges advisor to determine your status)

Examples of things that may be used to establish assessment:

- SAT/ACT scores within 3 years
- Previous college coursework (transcripts required)
- ACCUPLACER examination within 3 years



Residency Determines Tuition & Fees

- Active duty military and their family members stationed in Texas are eligible for in-state rates. Military ID and verification may be required



Proof of Prerequisites

- All skill level (assessment) and course prerequisites (prior college coursework) must be met before registration
