## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### HYBRID COURSES

\*Hybrid courses combine face-to-face classroom instruction with online learning. Classes meet regularly, but for less time than traditional classes. The remaining time, students access the class web site for assignments, lecture notes, tutorials, discussions and exams. To be successful in a hybrid course, students should be self-directed and self-motivated in their learning and study habits.

### MILITARY STUDENTS

Approved tuition assistance forms must be faxed or submitted in person to the business office at the college(s) you are attending. Students are responsible for ensuring faxed TA vouchers have been applied to their tuition bill by the payment deadline. Students will be dropped from all classes if there is a balance owed on their account.

### CIVILIAN STUDENTS
