[Astrophysics Data System \(ADS\)](#) - Web Access, 1975 - present. (NASA)

NASA-funded project whose main resource is an Abstract Service, which includes three sets of abstracts: 1) astronomy and astrophysics, containing approximately 594m468 abstracts; 2) instrumentation, containing approximately 586,979 abstracts; and 3) physics and geophysics, containing approximately 910,562 abstracts. In addition to the Abstract Service, the ADS provides pointers to astronomical data catalogs and data archives, making data collected by NASA space missions available.

Offers users access to information from all journals indexed in the National Library of Medicine's MEDLINE file. Gain access to information from such fields as medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system and preclinical sciences. Links to full text of over 350 full text journals. Included are abstracts and indexing for over 3,800 current biomedical journals published in the U.S. and 70 foreign countries, and citations found in Index Medicus, the International Nursing Index and the Index to Dental Literature. Additionally, table of contents information for 2,400 titles (provided by the British Document Supply Centre) and a Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) index with tree numbers, tree hierarchy is also included.

MEDLINEplus

MEDLINEplus has extensive information from the National Institutes of Health and other trusted sources on over 600 diseases and conditions. Natural & Alternative Treatments (EBSCO)



The database contains almost two hundred articles on medical conditions, presenting in an evidence-based manner the alternative medicine therapies proposed for use in their treatment. It also contains detailed, evidence-based information on herbs and supplements, functional foods, and other alternative therapies such as acupuncture and homeopathy. The evidence-based content has been developed and reviewed by

a team of physicians and pharmacologists with the goal of providing consumers with reliable information.

National Archeological Database

Dates of coverage vary. (U.S. National Park Service) Updated periodically. Contains approximately 240,000 reports on archeological investigation and planning, mostly of limited circulation. This "gray literature" represents a large portion of the primary information available on archeological sites in the U.S.

National Criminal Justice Reference Service

It also supports the Office of National Drug Control Policy.

NetLibrary E-books (NetLibrary)

Electronic books available through netLibrary and provided by TexShare. Titles may be checked out for 24 hours. Off-campus access: Current SPC students, faculty, and staff must click on the "Create an account" link after entering netLibrary in order to search for and check out eBooks. Other individuals must "Create an account" from a publicly accessible computer at the SPC Library or any other TexShare library in order to have access.
