



	<p>Financial aid problems may arise if student is receiving a scholarship or loan from SPC. This transition affects approximately 1200 students, 500 who are on financial aid. NLC will take the lead on the financial aid issue, however it will still require involvement from SPC. NLC provided a list of students which will be distributed to SPC AIRs who will be responsible for contacting these students.
